CE marking - A little history

It is already established in the "Treaty of Rome" in 1957 the need to remove the technical barriers that impede the free movement of goods (Art. 100 & 30 -36). Later (1985) it was stated the principle that a product lawfully marketed in one Member State can be legally marketed on the territory of other Member States and also the needs of safety, health and environmental protection should be harmonized in Europe through the Community Directives.

New Approach

In 1985, the new standards have been adopted for the approximation of the laws of the member states. It was determined that:

- •Directives cover the essential health, safety, hygiene and environmental protection.
- •The further technical specifications are defined by the Technical Standards "harmonized" developed by the European Institutes for Standardization (CEN, CENELEC and ETSI) under mandate of the Commission.

Global Approach

A new milestone was reached in 1993 with the Council Decision 93/446 / EEC, which introduced the Modular System uniquely identifying the principles and procedures for the assessment of conformity and the affixing of the CE marking. Conformity assessment can be performed using one or more of the following modules, as provided for by the Directive reference:

- A Module (Internal production control)
- **B Module (EC type-examination)**
- C Module (Conformity to type)
- D Module (Production quality assurance)
- **E Module (Product quality assurance)**
- F Module (Product verification)
- **G** Module (Testing a single product)
- **H Module (Total quality assurance)**

All modules require the intervention of a Notified Body, except A Module.

Directives subsequent to 7 May 1985 in accordance with the "New Approach": cover only the legal aspects, focus on the essential safety requirements; introduce the principle of presumption of conformity for products marked and accompanied by the EC Declaration of Conformity; voluntary return to the use of harmonized standards; ascribe to the manufacturer (or his representative) is responsible for issuing the Declaration of Conformity and affix the CE marking.



In most cases, the manufacturer may proceed independently to assess conformity of their product while maintaining appropriate documentation (**technical file**). In other cases, for those products that the European legislator has judged potentially riskier, is scheduled to attend a third body part, or Notified Body.
